c) presentation of the academic/artistic purpose of the above-mentioned study and the results achieved along with presentation of the possible use.

The source biography, using editorial methods, is a biography of one of key figures of Polish democratic opposition. The source biography uses original unknown sources (e.g. manuscripts, archives, accounts of eyewitnesses) confronted with each other. It enabled reconstruction of the point of view of Jan Józef Lipski on reality and changed the interpretation of some historical events (e.g. the revelation of a fact, that Jan Józef Lipski was the actual co-author of The Letter of 34).

5. Presentation of other academic and research (artistic) achievements.

Reconstructions of the legendary events of the newest history using original primary sources, attempts to understand the motivation of historical figures' decisions.
